

No. Most of our studytrips are open to all levels, including complete beginners.

# Can I join by myself?

Yes. Most people travel solo and make new friends during the trip.

# Are flights included?

Flights are not included. This gives you the flexibility to choose your airline, dates and route.

# Are meals included?

Meals are not included as standard, but some activities do involve food, like our welcome dinner or cooking classes.

# What's the average age?

Most participants are in their 20s - 30s, but we welcome anyone aged 18 and above.

# When will I get my schedule?

You'll receive the final activity schedule about one month before your trip starts.

# How do I pay?

Pay a small application fee to reserve your place. The rest is due before the booking deadline. You can pay via PayPal, WISE or bank transfer.

# What language are the activities in?

Most activities are in English. If any are in Japanese, our staff will be there to translate.

# Can I bring a friend or partner?

Yes. You can even get a group discount if you apply together.

### Do I need a visa?

Most travellers can join on a tourist visa. We'll help you confirm the requirements based on your passport.
