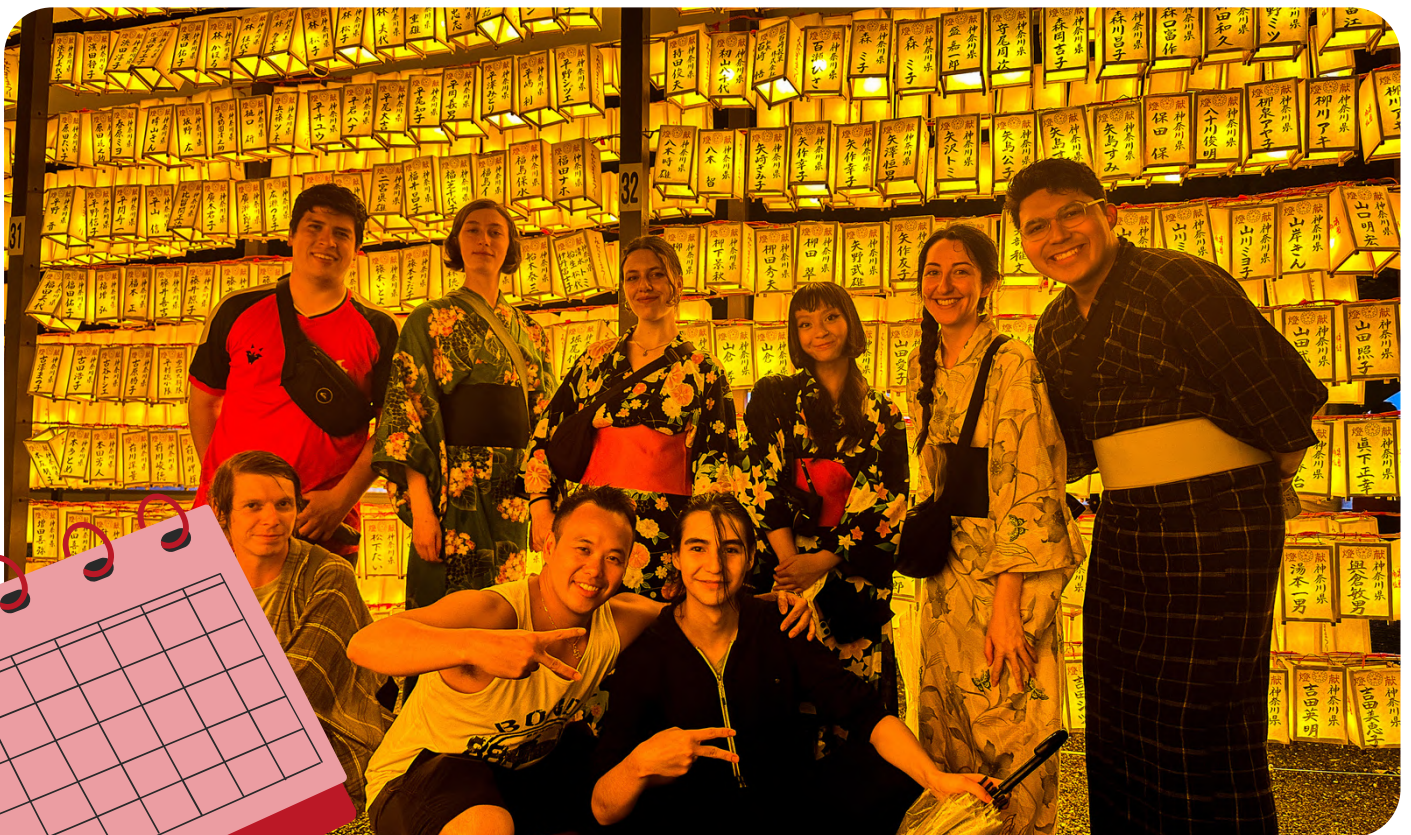

Frequently Asked Questions



Do I need to speak Japanese?

No. Most of our studytrips are open to all levels, including complete beginners.

Can I join by myself?

Yes. Most people travel solo and make new friends during the trip.

Are flights included?

Flights are not included. This gives you the flexibility to choose your airline, dates and route.

Are meals included?

Meals are not included as standard, but some activities do involve food, like our welcome dinner or cooking classes.

What's the average age?

Most participants are in their 20s - 30s, but we welcome anyone aged 18 and above.

When will I get my schedule?

You'll receive the final activity schedule about one month before your trip starts.

How do I pay?

Pay a small application fee to reserve your place. The rest is due before the booking deadline. You can pay via PayPal, WISE or bank transfer.

What language are the activities in?

Most activities are in English. If any are in Japanese, our staff will be there to guide and translate.

Can I bring a friend or partner?

Yes. You can even get a group discount if you apply together.

Do I need a visa?

Most travellers can join on a tourist visa. We'll help you confirm the requirements based on your passport.
